

- 23.02.2022: Nvidia's RTX 30-series ethereum mining limiter might've just gone up in smoke [link]
 - With LHR Unlocker, RTX 30 series can be used for crypto mining
 - Still a problem: miners use GPU to mine crypto currencies: e.g., RX 6500 XT
 - "Unfortunately, the price only qualifies as "budget" in today's world of radically inflated GPU prices, and even then, it will likely sell for far more than its official \$199 MSRP." [source]

 - Classic ethers from the DAO hack
 - "ETH now trading around \$3,000, 3.64 million ETH would be worth \$11 billion" → good for attracting clicks. ETC is ~\$24 → \$87 million (other DeFi hacks)

- "Chainalysis de-mixed the Wasabi transactions and tracked their output to four exchanges"
- 2016 Bitfinex hack: Two Arrested for Alleged Conspiracy to Launder \$4.5 Billion in Stolen Cryptocurrency [link]
 - "Three years later, as Bitcoin prices spiked, the launderers employed a type of transaction known as a "coinjoin," using Wasabi Wallet"
- Attention: this also happened, but clues are stronger
