- 05.02.2022: Decentralizing Distribution [link]
  - F-Droid received grant from Filecoin to work on decentralizing distribution
  - App/Play store: "become a source of unbridled control, censorship and surveillance"
  - "We are not looking at NFTs, blockchain, DAOs, smart contracts or related aspects of "Web3"."
- 16.03.2022: Making Sense of Crypto & Web3: Announcing our new initiative [link]
  - "from "it will revolutionize governance" to "it's a complete waste of time""

- "Web3 is generally understood as a potential "next generation" internet based on decentralized, blockchain-based systems."
- For me: connect browser to blockchain X
- 01.03.2022: Arti 0.1.0 is released: Your somewhatstable API is here! [link]
  - ~275k LoC from C to Rust
  - "It's nowhere near ready to replace the main Tor implementation in C, but we believe that it's the future"
  - Funded by Zcash

- 11.03.2022: How Podman can transfer container images without a registry [link]
  - New command: podman image scp
  - Not compatible with docker:
    - docker save → tar file
    - scp tar file
    - docker load
- 04.03.2022: BBR vs CUBIC: BBR improves performance by 21% [link]
  - Lecture topic: congestion control, many HTTP3/Quic uses BBR

- As CDN, Fastly is used → can switch congestion control algorithms
- Best Connections: 2-6% improvement, poor Connections: up to 21% improvement
- "ASN for which the response times increased after switching to BBR"
- 11.03.2022: Hedge Fund Fir Tree Bets Big With Short of Stablecoin Tether [link]
  - Short-selling: profit from stocks (here tokens)
    when they go down in value
  - USDT = stable coin, but legal/compliance questions, reserves available?
    - \$24 billion in high-yield assets (Chinese real estate)
