- 13.10.2021: How Coinbase Phishers Steal One-Time Passwords [link]
 - Followup
 - "sign up new accounts under the email addresses of more than 2.5 million Italians"
 - "But the phishers in this case likely weren't interested in registering any accounts. Rather, the bad guys understood that any attempts to sign up using an email address tied to an existing Coinbase account would fail. After doing that several million times, the phishers would then take the email addresses that failed new account signups and target them with Coinbasethemed phishing emails."

 "The best advice to sidestep phishing scams is to avoid clicking on links that arrive unbidden in emails"
