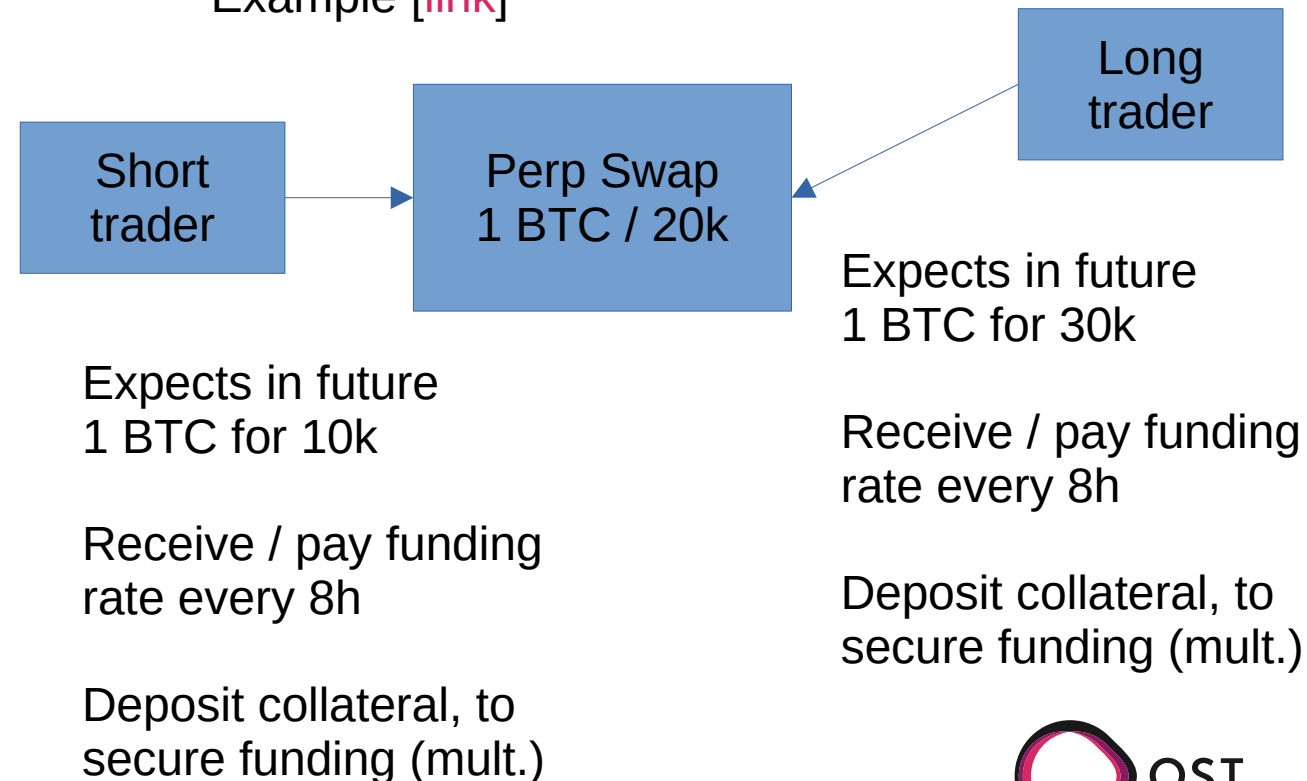

- 12.10.2022: Everything We Know About the Mango Markets Hack [\[link\]](#)
 - Trading platform on Solana, trades perps
 - 2 accounts with 5m collateral, one to short MNGO perp, one to long MNGO **perp**
 - Pump the price of MNGO by 2'400% with a few million USDC
 - Buy MNGO on the market → low liquidity
 - Long position account \$420m unrealized profits
 - Used as collateral for taking out loans on all coins on the Mango platform [\[link\]](#)
 - “Mango wasn’t hacked, it worked exactly as intended” [\[link\]](#) - known issue? [\[link\]](#)

- What are Perpetual Contracts
 - Contract between two parties to sell or buy an asset at a fixed price without an execution date
