



 - Bring users from CEX to DEX
 - Single-sided staking, no impermanent loss
 - But, potentially bugs or exploits
 - No investment advise!
- 16.11.2022: Building a BFT JSON CRDT [link]
 - Conflict-free Replicated Data Type
 - ~ git merge without conflicts
 - 12.11.2022:
 - CRDT: Fractional Indexing [link]

 - "For bitcoin proponents, the seeming stabilization signals a breather on the way to new heights.
